Tour - Fanad Head Lighthouse

Take a guided tour of the Fanad Head Lighthouse.

Fanad Lighthouse is one of the Great Lighthouses of Ireland, an all-Ireland tourism initiative developed by the Commissioners of Irish Lights.

Fanad Lighthouse was opened to the public as a visitor attraction in 2016. It is a not-for-profit social enterprise run by voluntary local committee Forbairt Fhánada Cuideachta. Rooted in the community, it is the flagship visitor attraction of the Fanad peninsula, an area of outstanding natural beauty which has much to offer the visitor.





Fanad Peninsula

After your lighthouse tour, enjoy a scenic drive of the Fanad Peninsula.

Wild, remote, and breathtakingly beautiful, the Fanad Peninsula is one of Donegal's most scenic gems. Its crown jewel is the iconic Fanad Head Lighthouse, perched dramatically above the Atlantic Ocean. Rugged coastal cliffs, quiet beaches, and winding roads make this area perfect for leisurely drives and coastal exploration. A highlight on the Wild Atlantic Way.

Visit the Giant's Causeway Visitor Centre

Enjoy a self guided tour of the Giants Causeway Visitors Centre, the Giant's Causeway is composed of thousands of strangely symmetrical basalt columns which jut out to sea between Port Ganny and Port Noffer. Legend has it that the whole Causeway was built by the Irish giant, Finn MacCool, so as to travel dry-shod across the sea to Scotland. Generations of guides have embroidered the tale until it is hard to disentangle modern invention from ancient folklore. In fact the Causeway is a product of the volcanic activity, which altered the face of Ireland, Scotland, Iceland and Greenland many millions of years ago.

Today, you will take a self-guided tour of this iconic site. After, enjoy a scenic drive back to the hotel, via Portrush and Portstewart.





Travel to Portrush

Portrush is a small seaside resort town on the north coast of County Antrim, Northern Ireland. It neighbours the resort of Portstewart. The main part of the old town, including the railway station as well as most hotels, restaurants and bars, is built on a 1 mile –long peninsula, Ramore Head.

Start in the lively village of Dunfanaghy—home to art galleries, surf shops, and beautiful Killahoey Beach—then wind your way to Falcarragh, a Gaeltacht town surrounded by beaches, bogs, and the majestic Derryveagh Mountains. Expect dramatic views, peaceful countryside, and the warm hospitality of northwest Ireland.
